45 3 Rare Tairona Stone Scepters, c.700-1500 AD

A set of three highly rare and important Pre-Columbian green stone scepters / staffs. Colombia, Tairona culture, Santa Marta, c.700-1500 AD. Each with tapering blade, decorated butt and a slate green color. The tallest having a deeply incised face and headdress, adorned with two double serpent motifs, 17.5" high, 2.5" wide. The second, also incised, tapers to a stylized double serpent head bearing teeth and incised in two geometric bands along the shaft, 13.75" high, 2.75" wide. The third is plain with carved lateral and terminal notches on the butt, 15.25" x 3.5" wide. Each with metal mounts.

These objects are quite rare and are only known to have been published in one source, the "Anthropological Series, Vol XX, No 1, Field Museum of Natural History by J. Alden Mason in 1931. For further reference and an example see Wikipedia under Tairona.
